GSBI also manages the Global Virtual Classroom Project (GVC) - a free, online educational program for primary and secondary school students from around the world.

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The GVC Contest, a multi-national team website design contest provides an opportunity for primary and secondary schools students from different countries to work and learn from students in other countries, as they collaboratively design a website on a topic of their choosing. Plaques and cash awards are presented to the schools of the winning teams and each student receives a certificate of participation. The winning primary and secondary school teams are each awarded \$3,000 for first prize, \$1,000 for second prize, and \$750 for third prize.

The GVC Clubhouse offers a non-competitive opportunity for students to work with their peers from other countries on a variety of collaborative learning projects ranging from language class exchanges, environmental research, collaborative science projects, and discussion groups.

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
